Despite being ill and in the hospital, we watched the Celtic Woman Christmas special on PBS together while she laid in the hospital bed and we kept listening to Celtic Woman music. It gave her something to keep fighting for and it gave me peace to be strong and it provided a way to escape the bad times around me. It was extremely rare that I wasn't listening to something Celtic Woman during that time every moment of the day, especially if it was you who was singing.

Thank goodness she made it through the surgery and gets stronger every day. So when the concert came, she was right there with me and it was just so special for the both of us. She **LOVES** Mairead and how she dances across the stage.

It is my dream to meet you one day so that I may thank you in person. Hopefully next year I can manage to afford the PBS tickets so my grandmother and I can get front row tickets and meet and greet passes. I know I've said this already but you've been a miracle in my life and so on your special day, I want to say thank you. Thank you for sharing your voice and your heart with the world.
